OUR MISSION:

To advance the physical, mental and emotional well-being of the working uninsured to improve quality of life for all.

VIMJAX has two clinics that offer patient care six days per week: the flagship Dorion-Burt Clinic in South San Marco (32207) and the West Jacksonville Clinic (32210). VIMJAX's "medical home" approach includes the management of common chronic conditions such as diabetes, hypertension, and anxiety. Regular preventive screenings help ensure that cancers and other potential health issues are identified in early stages, when they are more responsive to treatment. VIMJAX also provides specialty care for eighteen specialties, including cardiology, dermatology, ENT, endocrinology, gastroenterology, gynecology, hematology/oncology, mental health, neurology, nutrition, ophthalmology, orthopedics, pain management, podiatry, psychology, pulmonology, rheumatology, tobacco cessation, urology and more.

VIMJAX is based on a Medical Home model of care. We treat the whole person, striving to help each patient achieve their highest possible level of physical, mental, and emotional well-being.

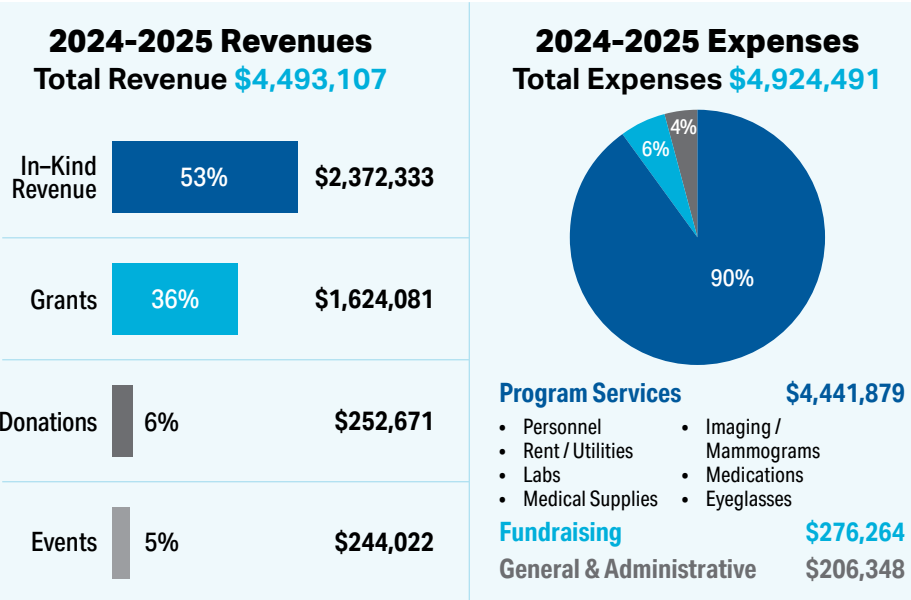
OUR STRATEGIC PLAN:

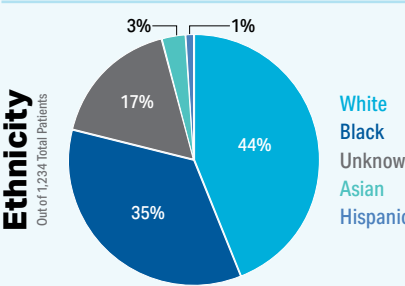
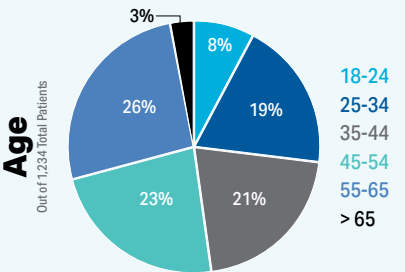
OUR PATIENTS

VIMJAX provides quality healthcare to working adults without health insurance – either because it is not offered through their employer or because they can't afford the premiums. Our patients work at least twenty hours per week and earn no more than 325% above the Federal Poverty Level.

During FY2024-2025, VIMJAX provided services for 1,231 unique adults. Women made up 70% of patients. Nearly 50% were living in single-adult households.

OUR VOLUNTEERS

Many of VIMJAX's medical volunteers are retired clinicians who enjoy working with patients, mentoring new physicians, and keeping their skills sharp. VIMJAX serves as a teaching facility for annual cohorts of interns, fellows, and nursing students from Mayo Clinic, Ascension St. Vincent's, HCA Florida Orange Park, Jacksonville University, and the University of North Florida. Together with VIMJAX's professional team, they provide healthcare services on par with any private clinic in Northeast Florida. In FY2025, VIMJAX volunteers included 176 clinicians, including 19 MD/DOs, 56 RNs, 10 pharmacists, and 16 EMTs. Specialists included cardiologists, endocrinologists, surgeons, gynecologists, neurologists, oncologists, ophthalmologists, psychiatrists, dermatologists, and urologists.

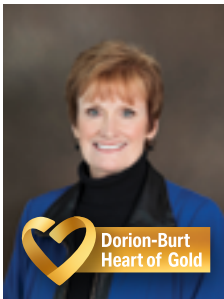

VIMJAX's patient care exceeds national Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS) performance measures for ensuring patients have timely mammograms and other cancer screenings, and for helping patients control their symptoms of hypertension and diabetes.



Percentage of primary care patients whose body mass index (BMI) was documented. 701 unique patients had an appointment / 699 had a BMI reading.



Percentage of female patients 50–74 years of age who had at least one mammogram to screen for breast cancer in the past two years. 219 female patients between ages 50-74 / 165 had a mammogram
